1. PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

1.2	Product type	Effective cleaner, which removes even the most stubborn dirt. Ideal pretreatment for Bondex Impregnation. Especially developed for wood-plastic composites (WPC). Refreshes the surface and preserve the natural appearance. Acts antistatically. (Please note that WPC is not a generic and uniform material, but depends on quality of raw materials and manufacturer).

1.5	Special qualities	Bondex WPC Cleaner removes dirt, lime, bird droppings, environmental deposits, greasy and oily impurities, and is a special cleaning agent designed for e.g. decking made from WPC.

2.5	Dilution	Mix with water - see 3. Application.
2.6	Consumption	Very economical.
2.7	Additives	Ingredients as per Regulation (EC) No 648/2004 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 31 March 2004 on detergents: <5% anionic surfactants, <5% nonionic surfactants methylchloroisothiazolinone, methylisothiazolinone, fragrances, limonene, citronellal.
2.8	Storage	Store and transport frost free in tightly closed container.
2.9	Shelf life	Can be kept in unopened containers for several years. Close containers securely after use.





3. SURFACE & PREPARATION

3.1	Stains or heavy soiling	Add approx. 200 ml to a 10 litre bucket (mixing ratio: 1:50) of warm water. Apply with a floor mop or damp cloth. Go over the area with a scrubbing brush or stiff-bristled brush and pick up dislodged dirt. Finally, wipe with clean water.
3.2	Maintenance cleaning	Add approx. 50 ml to a 10 litre bucket (mixing ratio: 1:200) of warm water and mix well. Wipe with a floor mop or cloth and leave to dry. There is no need to wipe over afterwards. Using Bondex WPC Cleaner is not a substitute for the annual surface treatment of WPC surfaces. If you wish to apply a protective treatment to the surface, treat with Bondex Impregnation once dry.
3.3	Application instruction	Shake well before use. Not suitable for application and drying at temperatures below $+10^{\circ}\text{C}$ and/or relative humidity of >80%. Ensure that all of the product used on a single surface has the same batch number.
3.4	Cleaning of tools	Warm water.

4.1	In general	Common safety rules for work with paints and varnishes must be observed. Further information is available from our Material Safety Data Sheet.
4.2	Disposal	Do not empty into drains or into the environment. Product waste must not be poured into the sewers, water reserves or soil.
